

## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

***We at Austin Contract Services Ltd recognise that Waste Management activities may have an adverse environmental impact, arising from:***

- The direct use of fossil fuels in vehicles and the transportation of staff and materials
- Stockpiling and spreading operations

We have a commitment to:-

- Protect the environment and to prevent pollution in particular to such matters as the pollution of watercourses
- Complying with current U.K. legal environmental legislation
- Enhancing our environmental management system and environmental performance
- Providing a framework for setting environmental objectives that focus on enhancing our environmental performance and monitoring/discussing these at regular intervals at senior management level.

To limit the environmental impact of our business operations we ensure:

- That we assess the environmental impact of any contracted service activity or related procurement strategy before any change is made and in particular in relation to the location and management of stockpiles;
- That all our plant and vehicles are maintained in accordance with the manufactures recommendations at intervals recommended;
- Spreading Activities are managed in relation to ground conditions to limit the impact this will have on soil compaction.
- That vehicle movements are limited to those necessary for the planned activities;
- That all control equipment is routinely calibrated and serviced, and that control parameters are continuously monitored and reviewed to ensure maximum efficiency and utilisation of inputs.

We will provide a framework to continuously evaluate, as part of ongoing Environmental and Operational Health and Safety Assessments, the environmental impact of our operational activities and material input sourcing strategies in an effort to reduce total CO<sub>2</sub> emissions through management review and challenge.


We commit where possible to use materials that have the lowest environmental impact consistent with the expectations of our customers and to fulfil our compliance obligations as specified in legislation.

- We will also, as a matter of Policy, commit to undertake Purchase recycled consumables (Paper Inks and Packaging) where these alternatives are available.
- Recycle Waste arising from Business Operations or where such recycling is not practically possible, place these materials for Recovery (extraction of heat).
- Provide and maintain spillage containment equipment to ensure that accidental leakage of liquid inputs will not enter controlled waters.
- Continuously monitor operational activities to ensure that soil compaction, and odours from spreading operations are effectively managed, and that an excess heat, lighting, water or cleansing materials is not applied, consistent with any standards set in law and by customers.

Finally, we commit to a continual improvement of the environmental management system to enhance environmental performance through documented information that we will communicate to workers and interested parties as necessary.
